Amendment of the Curriculum for the master's programme in Banking and Finance

passed by the Ssenat of the University of Vienna in Januaryy 2021

§ 3 Entry requirements

- (1) To be admitted to the master's programme in Banking and Finance students must have completed an eligible bachelor's programme or an eligible bachelor's programme at a university of applied sciences or an equivalent degree programme at a recognised Austrian or foreign post-secondary educational institution.
- (2) The following bachelor's programmes at the University of Vienna are certainly eligible: Business Administration, International Business Administration, Computer Science, Mathematics, Statistics, Economics and Business Informatics. These studies meet the qualitative admission requirements specified in para 3.
- (3) To graduates of other programmes, the following qualitative admission requirements apply in any case:
 - Command of English corresponding to at least the B2 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages; regarding the proof of the language level the regulations of the University of Vienna apply.
 - Prior courses in the fields of business administration, economics, mathematics and statistics, comprising 30 ECTS credits, of which at least 3 ECTS credits each must have been acquired in courses in mathematics and statistics.
- (4) The language of instruction of the master's programme in Banking and Finance is English. Students are allowed to choose elective subjects taught in German.
